## Fishing Concierge Service

### Fishing Charters 1/2 Day, 3/4 Day, and Full Day Available

Fishing the Florida Keys is epic because the waters surrounding the islands teem with fish. Marathon is a popular choice for fishermen due to the many species of fish found in our waters. With its unique location, anglers enjoy the most spectacular fishing in Florida 12 months a year.

Fishing charters are handled through our concierge service. Whether you want to fish the flats, hit the reef, maybe a wreck, or go offshore, we have the charter for you. We match your needs (budget, number of people, special needs, etc.) with one of our local fishing charters. Our Florida Keys fishing staff will tailor a fishing trip for you based on the type of angling and fish (in season) that you are interested in. We have over 25 charter boats in our fleet that are available to us and have handpicked our fishing Captains. Many of them hold world records and compete in many tournaments every year. Their boats, equipment and tackle meet our high standards of excellence. Many were born and raised here in the keys and have a unique knowledge of the surrounding waters and Marathon Florida fishing.

Planning ahead is very important as fishing charters tend to fill up quickly and you might miss a perfect opportunity. On a day when it's just too rough to fish offshore or on the reef, the bay works as an excellent alternative, as it's comfortable even in a stiff breeze. It's the perfect choice for family fun fishing. Call us so we may begin the process of finding the appropriate charter for you.

Because of the uniqueness of the Florida Keys, there are many types of fishing available. Our staff has narrowed them all down to 3 standard types of fishing Flats/Backcountry, Reef/Wreck, and Deep sea/Offshore.

The reef and wrecks lay 3 to 6 miles offshore. Grouper, snapper and yellowtail are just a few of the fish you can catch.



Just outside the reef and further offshore is some of the world's best sport fishing. You have the chance to catch Swordfish, Mahi Mahi, Sailfish, Marlin, Tuna, Amber Jack, Dolphin, Wahoo, Permit, Snook and King Fish.



The Florida Key's backcountry consists of hundreds of islands or "Keys" which are scattered amidst the rich waters of the Gulf of Mexico. Most of the backcountry Keys are pristine uninhabited islands. Fly fishermen can enjoy fishing the nearby flats and backcountry where Bonefish, Tarpon (Silver King) and Permit await.
